- 1 skein of bulky weight yarn (worsted weight yarn can also be used)
- Size H/8 (5mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Jacket: 3 months
- Hat: 3 months
- 4 stitches and 4 rows = 1 inch in half double crochet
- ch - chain
- dc - double crochet

- hdc - half double crochet
- sc - single crochet
- sl st - slip stitch
- st(s) - stitch(es)

Row 1: Ch 3, hdc into the 2nd ch from hook, hdc into each ch across. Turn. (6 sts)
Row 2: Ch 3, hdc into each st across. Turn. (6 sts)
Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 5 inches.

Next Row: Ch 3, hdc into the next st, dc into each st across. Turn. (7 sts)
Next Row: Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (7 sts)
Repeat last two rows 10 times.

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (7 sts)
Next Row: Ch 3, hdc into each st across. Turn. (7 sts)
Repeat last two rows 10 times.

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 2 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (8 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (8 sts)**Repeat last two rows 10 times.**

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 3 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (9 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (9 sts)**Repeat last two rows 10 times.**

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 4 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (10 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (10 sts)**Repeat last two rows 10 times.**

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 5 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (11 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (11 sts)**Repeat last two rows 10 times.**

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 6 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (12 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (12 sts)**Repeat last two rows 10 times.**

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 7 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (13 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (13 sts)**Repeat last two rows 10 times.**

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 8 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (14 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (14 sts)**Repeat last two rows 10 times.**

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 9 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (15 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (15 sts)**Repeat last two**

rows 10 times.

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 10 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (16 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (16 sts)**Repeat last two rows 10 times.**

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 11 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (17 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (17 sts)**Repeat last two rows 10 times.**

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 12 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (18 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (18 sts)**Repeat last two rows 10 times.**

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into the next 13 sts, hdc into each st across. Turn. (19 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (19 sts)**Repeat last two rows twice.**

Next Row: Ch 3, dc into each st across. Turn. (19 sts)**Next Row:** Ch 3, hdc into each st across. Turn. (19 sts)**Repeat last two rows four times.**

Next Row: Ch 3, hdc into the next 5 sts, sl st into each st across. Fasten off.

Hood

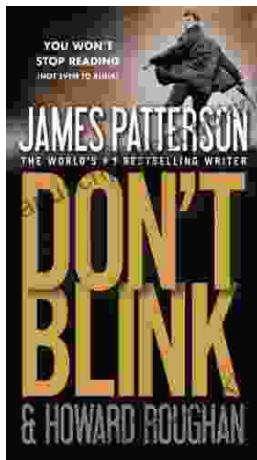
Rnd 1: Ch 3, hdc into the 2nd ch from hook, hdc into each ch across. Join with sl st to first hdc. (12 sts)**Rnd 2:** Ch 3, hdc into each st around. Join with sl st to first hdc. (



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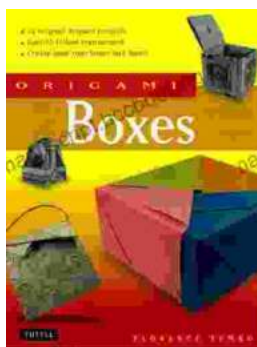
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
